LSA 20- and 22-meter twin track (Mk 2) inflatable slide-type marine evacuation system, for use with LSA 50- or 100-person inflatable liferaft, or 128-person inflatable buoyant apparatus for open reversible liferaft.

Nominal max rated capacity is 600 persons in 30 minutes. Max stowage height for 20 m slide is 12.5 m above the waterline in lightest undamaged sea-going condition, and 17.4 m considering unfavorable conditions of list and trim. Max stowage height for 22 m slide is 13.6 m above the waterline in lightest undamaged sea-going condition, and 18.8 m considering unfavorable conditions of list and trim. Evaluated, tested, and found to be in compliance with the IMO LSA Code (Res. MSC.48(66)), section 6.2, and IMO Res. A.689(17) (as amended through Res. MSC.81(70)), section 1/12.
